CHECK-IN PROCESS:

The following committees will check into Fairway One Ballroom in the Hilton, which is just north of the 9 Tee Pad for their shifts: Comp Support: Scorers and Spotters; Standard Bearers, Hospitality Services, Evacuation Team, and Hole Captains. Volunteers are encouraged to check in and then exit the ballroom to accommodate others.

All other committees/volunteers will continue to check in at their designated location provided by your committee chairperson, i.e., Player On-Course Shuttles will check in at the Player Shuttle Trailor located in the golf course parking lot. Gallery Management Ambassadors will report to their assigned hole, etc.

Please note, that there is no storage of personal items during the tournament.

<u>Volunteer Check-in & Dining is for WORKING VOLUNTEERS ONLY on assigned days.</u> No friends or family members are allowed access.

*A pre-approved drawstring backpack will be provided to all volunteers for use during the tournament & is the only backpack that can be used during the tournament.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

Thank you for volunteering for the 2025 Genesis Invitational. We appreciate your dedication and commitment. The tournament expects its volunteers to conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner, treating all tournament constituents with consideration and respect. This guiding principle embodies our Volunteer Code of Conduct, and we ask that you embrace it. To that end, we offer the following guidelines on how to conduct yourself, either on the grounds of the event or wherever you might be representing the tournament. Please note, this list is illustrative and not exhaustive of the behavior the tournament expects of its volunteers.

A VOLUNTEER SHOULD:

- Treat all guests, players, caddies, and fellow volunteers with courtesy and respect
- Prioritize safety and follow all safety protocols
- Wear the appropriate tournament approved uniform
- Abide by all tournament policies and procedures
- Fulfill your committee shift minimum requirement
- Complete all shifts assigned unless otherwise communicated with the tournament or committee chair
- Perform all tasks and duties asked by the committee chair
- Be punctual

A VOLUNTEER SHOULD NOT:

- Ask Professionals for autographs or photos at any time while serving tournament week
- Consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol while serving tournament week (including breaks) or while in your volunteer uniform
- Smoke or be under the influence of any chemicals or drugs
- Violate any applicable law, regulation or ordinance

- Engage in any type of discriminatory or harassing behavior based on race, color, religion, gender, age, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, veteran status, military status, genetic information or any other status or condition protected by local, state or federal law
- Allow another individual to use your volunteer credentials
- Seek autographs, solicit gratuities, gifts or bequests for personal or professional benefit
- Enter restricted areas or inside the ropes without proper credentials
- Leave tasks or posts unattended
- Use vulgar or offensive language
- Resell credentials

GOLF ETIQUETTE:

- Please be quiet when Gallery Management Ambassadors raise their hands prior to and during any shot
- Cheer and applaud a great shot
- Please refrain from moving or walking when a player is preparing to hit a shot
- Respect the players' concentration. Do not try to attract attention or speak with them on the course
- Stay outside of the ropes in designated areas
- Wait for the Gallery Management Ambassadors' signal before crossing any fairways
- Treat all players, fans, guests, and fellow volunteers with courtesy and respect

If you are aware of, or suspect, conduct that is unlawful or violates this Code of Conduct or tournament policies and procedures, please notify Dora Seggelke at genesisvolunteer@tgrfoundation.org.

A violation of this Code of Conduct may lead to immediate removal of your volunteer credential, expulsion from the tournament grounds and the prevention from volunteering at future events.

CREDENTIAL

Your volunteer credential allows you access to the tournament grounds and shuttles Monday through Sunday, February 10-16, 2025. On the days you are not serving as a volunteer, and the tournament is open to the public (Thursday – Sunday), you are welcome to use your credential to access the tournament grounds as a guest.

PARKING

Volunteer parking will be located as follows:



- **Torrey Pines Gliderport is for working volunteers or uniform pick-up ONLY.
 - Uniform pick-up at The Gliderport will be available Monday-Wednesday of tournament week during the following hours:
 - o Monday, February 10 7:45 AM 2 PM
 - o Tuesday, February 11 9 AM 3 PM
 - o Wednesday, February 12 6 AM 2 PM
 - If you are unable to pick up your uniform and credentials during one of the distribution days, please pick it up from your committee chairperson on the day of your first shift.

Your volunteer credential is your parking pass – barcode will be scanned at the entrance to the lot.

**IMPORTANT UTC PARKING INFORMATION: You will receive a validated parking ticket when you exit the volunteer shuttle. This will be the only ticket you need to input into the validation machine when exiting the parking area. If you have any issues, please press the Call Button on the ticket machine and let them know you are a Genesis Invitational Volunteer.

The pick-up/drop-off location is outside of the Westfield UTC Valet Station on La Jolla Village Drive (noted in RED on the image above).

SHUTTLES:

Volunteer shuttles will run two hours before gate times on a continuous loop until 1 hour after the last putt drops.

Volunteer credentials will be needed to board the shuttle (or a screenshot of your shift schedule).

UNIFORM

Volunteers are asked to wear the appropriate 2025 tournament-issued uniform inclusive of:

- Black volunteer golf polo, black volunteer jacket (recommended to wear black pants, skorts, capris or shorts of appropriate length)
- Volunteer hat or visor
- Closed-toe footwear that is comfortable

VOLUNTEER FOOD AND BEVERAGE

BREAKFAST: Continental breakfast courtesy of Genesis will be provided in Volunteer Dining. Breakfast is first come, first served.

GRAB N' GO SNACKS: provided in Volunteer Dining. An assortment of granola bars, whole fruit, trail mix, etc. will be available to take on-course.

*To ensure we have enough for all volunteers, including those arriving for late-starting shifts, please only take enough for yourself. We thank you for your understanding!

LUNCH: Box Lunch or a physical concession voucher (distributed by your committee chair) will be provided during your assigned shift (varies by committee).

Concession vouchers valid for: One Entrée, Chips, Dessert Item, and a Beverage (Soda OR Water).

*Entrée Options Include: Burger (Beef/Veggie), Hot Dog, Turkey Wrap

Volunteer express window located at The Grove on hole 8 green.

*Please note: not all entrée options are available at every concession stand.

^{**}Clear ponchos will be provided to wear over personal rain gear, if needed.

GENERAL TOURNAMENT A-Z

FIRST AID

The medical tent is located on 14 Green, South Course, during competition hours.

If you are the first person to encounter an emergency, you should use the following procedures:

- Stay calm and ask for assistance from other volunteers or nearby spectators who may have witnessed the medical emergency.
- Seek tournament personnel equipped with radios. Provide your location and ask for immediate help.
- Assist the medical team in completing an incident report.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Please do not presume play is cancelled if it rains or if it is windy; report to your assigned duty and check in with your committee chairman. Volunteers will be informed ahead of time on what their instruction will be depending on the severity of the approaching weather. Your chairperson will communicate committee specific evacuation plans should they be needed.



- Alert messages are issued as the potential weather conditions could impact the tournament. Weather alerts will be assigned a color indicating a combination of the level of impact and the likelihood of severe weather.
- Alerts will be displayed based upon the information available at the time, and, therefore, may not be displayed in ascending order.

LOST AND FOUND

If a fan is looking for a lost item, please direct them to either of the two Guest Services locations at the South Entrance and the East Entrance. Please see the Lost & Found Procedures below:

Finding an Item

All items should be turned into Guest Services at either the East Entrance (between the Lodge and the Hilton) or the South Entrance (at Gliderport).

Either:

- Deliver the item to Guest Services yourself (if you are near or passing by)
- Get item to nearest security guard, who will then get it to Guest Services
- Get item to Hole Captain who will get it to the nearest security guard to take to Guest Services

Once received, Guest Services will take note of the lost item with information including:

- Date lost/turned in
- Location found
- Description of Item

At the end of each day, all items will be sent to the Tournament Office and will be kept for 30 days.

PROHIBITED ITEMS



No bags larger than a small purse 6"x6" including carrying cases, backpacks, camera bags, or chair bags (See the PGA TOUR Bag Policy for more information

No clear plastic, vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x6"x12"

No glass cups or bottles of any kind except for medical or infant needs



No memorabilia including pin flags, photos, trading cards, balls and other sports paraphernalia



No computers or laptops



No fireworks or laser pointers



No lounge or over-sized chairs with extended foot rests



No seat cushions in a carrying case or that have pockets or compartments



No pets, except for service animals



No knives, firearms or weapons of any nature



No video cameras (All Week)



No point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras (During Competition Rounds)



No selfie sticks or hand-held camera stabilizers



No beverages (patrons may not bring in or exit with beverages) or coolers



No radios, TVs, or portable speakers



No posters, signs or banners



No motorcycles, mopeds, tricycles, bicycles (whether or not motor-driven), skateboards, hoverboards, or other similar devices will be permitted to be operated on or within tournament property.

Segways®, motorized scooters or other personal transportation devices are prohibited if not used as a mobility aid by individuals with mobility impairment



No drones, Remote Controlled Model Aircrafts or other devices that can be operated in airspace will be permitted to be operated at PGA TOUR events during tournament week.

Driven by Genesis, this year's tournament will highlight and support relief efforts through the California Rises initiative.


California Rises will raise money for the following charities active in the rebuilding efforts:
